Companies Face Billions in Damages as PFAS Lawsuits Flood Courts

- More than 6,400 PFAS-related lawsuits filed since 2005
- Litigation presents "existential threat" to some companies

For years, plaintiffs' lawyers suing over health and environmental damage from so-called forever chemicals, known collectively as PFAS, focused on one set of deep pockets—E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Co.

But over the past two years, there's been a seismic shift in the legal landscape as awareness of PFAS has expanded. Corporations including 3M Co., Chemguard Inc., Kidde-Fenwal Inc., National Foam Inc., and Dynax Corp. are now being sued at roughly the same rate as DuPont, according to a Bloomberg Law analysis of more than 6,400 PFAS
