

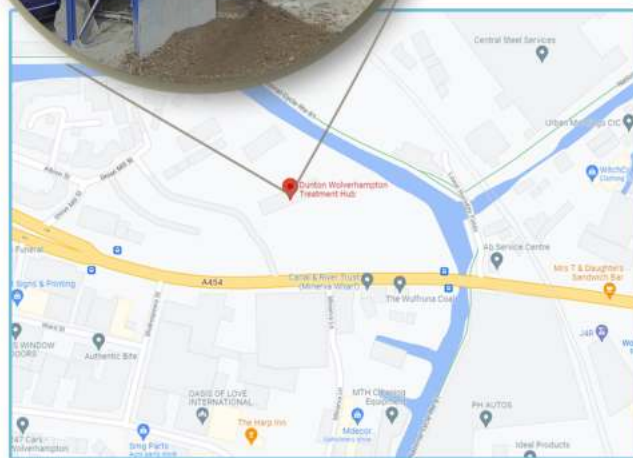


Wolverhampton Waste Treatment Facility

- Construction materials containing asbestos.
- Hydrocarbon impacted soils and wastes.
- Dredging spoil
- Street-cleaning residues.
- Effluent sludges and filter cakes.
- Waste management facilities and waste water treatment plants.
